DATA PROTECTION

Declaration on the obligation to inform

(Data protection declaration)

The protection of your personal data is of particular concern to us. We therefore process your data exclusively on the basis of the legal provisions (DSGVO, TKG 2003). In this data protection declaration, we inform you about the most important aspects of data processing within the framework of our website.

Contacting us

If you contact us using the contact form on the website or by e-mail, the data you provide will be stored by us for twelve months for the purpose of processing the enquiry and in case of follow-up questions. We will not pass on this data without your consent.

The data name, address, will be stored beyond that up to 5 years. The data processing is carried out on the basis of the legal provisions of § 96 para 3 TKG as well as Art 6 para 1 lit a (consent) and/or lit b (necessary for the fulfilment of the contract) of the DSGVO.

Applicants

Allea Austria GmbH (hereinafter referred to as "Allea") informs all its applicants about the collection of their personal data (all information that directly or indirectly relates to you and makes you identifiable or identifiable) and how it is processed.

Data processing in the context of the application process

Purpose:

Allea stores and processes your personal data while carrying out the application process (receiving application emails or conventional application, determining the suitability of applicants) and for subsequent admission to the company or to keep records of rejected applicants.

Legal basis:

Storage period

The personal data are generally stored for 6 months after the rejection of the application, in the case of keeping evidence of the applicant files, the data are stored until the consent has been revoked, beyond that until the end of any legal disputes in which the data are required as evidence.

Data subject rights:

Applicants have a right to information from Allea about the personal data concerning them, as well as a right to correction or deletion or to restriction of processing, as well as a right to object to processing and a right to data portability. Furthermore, applicants have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority (in Austria, the data protection authority based in Vienna).

Allea discloses in the context of the collection of data, should the provision of personal data be legally or contractually required for the applicant concerned or necessary for the conclusion of a contract. At the same time, Allea will disclose whether the applicant concerned is obliged to provide his/her personal data and what the possible consequences of not doing so would be.

Automated decision-making, including profiling, does not take place. If personal data is processed for a purpose other than that for which the personal data was collected, Allea will disclose this information about this other purpose to the applicant concerned.
